GENERAL INFORMATION

MYP CHOIR SYLLABUS

Please read the MYP Choir syllabus located at oxfordchoirs.com. To save paper and ink it is located online. Curriculum, grading and attendance policies are located in this document.

CONCERTS

Vocalists are required to participate in all of our choir concerts (exceptions can be made in certain situations). Oxford High School Choir concerts demonstrate high standards and always offer patrons and performers a memorable experience. The 2019-20 Concert Season offers some great entertainment! Note the concert schedule is included in this packet.

REHEARSALS

Students are expected to provide a high level of engagement in daily rehearsals. Students do not need to be great singers to find success in choir, they just need to be willing to provide maximum effort on a daily basis to contribute to their personal growth, as well as that of their choir. We have a saying in choir - "what we do - we do together." Everyone actively contributes in choir. We have another saying in choir - "serious-fun". Serious-fun means we all apply self discipline and focus on growth, while having a great time working towards it. Please note there are a few Wednesday morning required rehearsals that are included on the calendar in this packet.

UNIFORMS / UNIFORM FEE

Formal uniforms will be used for our Fall, Christmas and Winter concerts. Each member of our choirs will be loaned a school owned formal uniform in a uniform bag. In addition to the uniform provided girls MUST provide closed toe black shoes. Flats are recommended due to long periods of standing. Guys must provide black dress shoes and black dress socks and will be wearing a tuxedo with vest and long tie.

The Uniform Fee is \$20 per student. The uniform fee does not cover damaged uniforms. If your uniform is damaged you will be billed for repair or replacement. **The uniform fee is due by Wednesday September 4th.** Please let Mr. Card know if you need assistance in paying this fee.
